Celebrating Diversity

We celebrate diversity and adapt provision so all children — including those with SEND or emotional needs — can succeed.

Consistent and Proportionate

Sanctions and support are applied fairly, consistently and proportionately, considering individual circumstances.

Right to Feel Safe

Everyone has the right to feel safe and valued.
Bullying, harassment and discrimination are never tolerated.



Swift and Effective Action

We act swiftly and effectively to prevent and tackle bullying, following our Anti-Bullying (Togetherness) Policy.

High Expectations

We expect pupils to behave consistently well and show positive attitudes to learning.

Restorative Practice

Where behaviour falls short, we use restorative practice and emotion coaching before sanctions.

We teach self-regulation, resilience and problem-solving as part of our behaviour curriculum.
